

#### ACT II

### Background of Paquita

In Act 1 of Paquita, the setting introduces Paquita, a spirited young gypsy raised by a band of gypsies, and Lucien, a French officer. Their budding love story begins when Lucien becomes smitten with Paquita during a celebration. Despite the tension between their different social classes—Paquita being of humble origins and Lucien of noble birth—their affection for each other grows. The act features vibrant and energetic Spanish folk dances, showcasing both the joy and the cultural richness of the gypsy community. As the act concludes, Paquita's true identity remains a mystery, but the foundation of her love for Lucien is solidified, setting the stage for the revelations to come in later acts.

For our production, this is where we pick up the story, in Act II. We have since discovered that Paquita, initially believed to be a common gypsy, is actually of noble birth as the daughter of a Spanish count. Amidst a vibrant Spanish setting filled with joyful and exciting dances-including a grand pas de deux between Paquita and Lucien- the ballet concludes with the celebration of Paquita's newfound nobility and union with her love, Lucien. The ballet is marked by its spirited choreography and festive Spanish flair.
